Our Pregnancy Options Social worker- Counsellor will be on Annual Leave from Wednesday 30th May 2018 returning to the role on Wednesday July 4th 2018.

In her absence, there will be limited cover.

Due to this, 'Pregnancy Options Counselling' will be limited to the following:

- 6-11 week gestation- any woman who is undecided about either continuing or terminating her pregnancy will be required to be seen by Lakes DHB Rangiora Clinic for counselling.
- If your patient has considered and wishes to undergo Surgical TOP please refer directly to Lakes DHB Rangiora Clinic as per the normal Referral Process.
- 12+1 weeks to 17 weeks gestation requesting a 2nd Tri-Termination through the Epsom Day Unit will be seen by the Pregnancy Counsellor via the BOPDHB Service at Clinic 2. Please refer through usual process.
- Early gestation- wishing to use EMA process, please refer to Family Planning.
- There will be **NO Post Termination Counselling** during this time.

All referrals for counselling are to be sent to <u>Meg Beswick - Social Work Department</u> as per usual E-Process. These will then be forwarded to Trish Gilmore at Sexual Health Clinic for prioritising with Charis O'Neil - Social Worker Women's Health at Whakatane Hospital who will be acting in this role during Lilly's absence.
